**Susan Hillis** - Capt. Susan Hillis currently serves as a Senior Advisor in Global Health at the US Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC). She recently served as a CDC Senior HIV Scientist, with research addressing prevention of perinatal HIV, infant abandonment, teen pregnancy, violence against children and youth, suicide, orphans, vulnerable children, street youth, Adverse Childhood Experiences (ACEs), infectious diseases, and life-long psychosocial dysfunction. Dr. Hillis has authored or coauthored over 100 papers in peer reviewed journals and has spoken widely at national and international governmental and civil society meetings.

**Rebecka Lundgren** - Rebecka Lundgren is Director of Research for the Institute for Reproductive Health at Georgetown University. Dr. Lundgren has over 25 years of experience developing and testing reproductive health and behavior change programs, with a particular focus on expanding family planning choice, youth, gender-based violence and engaging men in reproductive health. She earned an MPH from UCLA's School of Public Health in the Department of Population and Family Health, and her doctorate in applied anthropology at the University of Maryland.
