



- Facts do not back up the perception














# "Immigrant Optimism"

#### **New Immigrant Destinations**

- New jobs in agriculture/meat packing, manufacturing, construction, and high-end services
- Social networks connect immigrants to jobs
- Now they are growing because of births than migration

#### Reception of new immigrants
